**GLO to Launch Non-Stop Service to Destin-Fort Walton Beach Airport**  
*Public Charter Operator to Offer Seasonal Service to the Emerald Coast*

**NEW ORLEANS, La.** – Regional air service provider **GLO** (*Pronunciation: /glow/*) is proud to formally announce it will expand its non-stop service from Central Arkansas to Florida’s Emerald Coast. The startup public charter operator will offer a quality alternative to travelers who have been relegated to timely connections and exhausting road travel due to an absence of non-stop air service between Bill and Hillary Clinton National Airport (LIT) and Destin-Fort Walton Beach Airport (VPS).

GLO’s public charter flights, operated by Corporate Flight Management, Inc. (CFM), will introduce non-stop service from Little Rock to Destin-Fort Walton Beach on Fridays, Saturdays and Sundays beginning Friday, March 25, 2016. The service will run through Monday, September 5, 2016 beginning with one-way, introductory “GLOfort” \$149 fares (tax included).

Due to GLO’s economical fare structure, travelers will realize a cost-effective and timely alternative to driving to and from the Emerald Coast. GLO’s passengers will be able to enjoy more of their time visiting Florida’s white sand beaches.

“Since day one, we always knew we wanted to expand our service to continue restoring non-stop flights to cities in our region that had historically been connected,” said Trey Fayard, GLO’s Founder and CEO. “On GLO, we want to make travel easy, convenient and comfortable, and we’re doing that through our seasonal service to one of the greatest beach regions in the world – Destin-Fort Walton Beach.”

GLO will be Destin-Fort Walton Beach Airport’s fifth air carrier and increases the amount of destinations to nine. The new service increases Bill and Hillary Clinton National Airport’s number of destinations to 14. GLO will also be offering non-stop flights during the same time between Louis Armstrong New Orleans International Airport and Destin-Fort Walton Beach.

“We welcome GLO to Florida’s Emerald Coast and are thrilled to build a partnership at the Destin-Fort Walton Beach Airport,” Tracy Stage, Interim Airports Director, Okaloosa County Airports, said. “The team has worked with GLO for a few years and are at the right place at the right time for GLO’s model.

“We’re thrilled that GLO will be expanding to offer nonstop service to Destin-Fort Walton Beach,” said Ronald F. Mathieu, Clinton National Airport Executive Director. “Families will be able to reach the beautiful, white sand beaches much quicker without facing a long drive.”

GLO’s operator, CFM, will again deploy 30-passenger Saab 340B aircraft, known for its comfort and reliability, on the new routes. On-board service provided by a flight attendant will include complimentary snacks and beverages from the regions GLO services, as well as local publications. GLO passengers also may transport up to three bags and one personal item free of charge.
