Clinton National Airport Installs New Gate Seating with Power Outlets
Original gate seats replaced to complement technology upgrades and provide better experience

LITTLE ROCK, ARK. (August 16, 2017) – Relax and recharge with all new gate seating at Bill and Hillary Clinton National Airport. According to airport technology consultants, Clinton National Airport is the first airport in the country to feature in-seat power at every gate. Each seat has access to both 110 volt and 5 amp quick USB to allow passengers to easily recharge devices before boarding. Passengers will also enjoy extra space between seats for additional comfort.

The new 802 seats are a part of \$25 million of concourse improvements to improve comfort and convenience.

Other enhancements include:

- A modernized interior
- Chick-fil-A and Chili's and additional shopping to open in 2018
- A new Wi-Fi system powering the fastest, free Wi-Fi of any airport
- New jet bridges
- Larger arrival and departure monitors
- Additional restrooms
- Distributed antenna system to boost cellular service

As Arkansas' largest commercial airport serving nearly 2 million passengers annually, Clinton National is home to five airlines with approximately 70 daily arrivals and departures. The airport has earned a 98% overall passenger satisfaction score by Phoenix Marketing International following a total of nearly \$90 million of renovations.

The state of Arkansas estimates that Clinton National makes a \$1.2 billion economic impact each year. The airport is debt free, and uses no local, state or federal tax dollars for operations.
